# ANGKOR WAT TOUR

## SCHEDULE

<b>DAY 1:</b>	<b>HIROSHIMA TO SIEM REAP via BANGKOK</b> 10:20am Departure from Hiroshima 16:25-18:10 Arrive at Siem Reap(Angkor Wat) via Bangkok Meet a travel guide and transfer to hotel. Arrive in Siem Reap, meet our guide to transfer to the hotel for check-in.  Dinner at a restaurant	Overnight in hotel, Siem Reap
<b>DAY 2:</b>	<b>Breakfast at the hotel</b> Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at 8.30am for a tour to the Roluos group of temples built in the 9th century (Lolei, Bakong and Preah Ko) to see the precedents of the great Angkor temples. Sightseeing of Angkor Thom, the great city located next to Angkor Wat. Angkor Thom was the greatest achievement of King Jayavarman VII. Built in the late 12th century, it extends almost 4 square miles and is enclosed by a wall 26 feet high, 7.5 miles long and surrounded by an originally crocodile-infested moat. This great city contains many structures built to honour the Buddha and had amenities for the king and people to enjoy. The area is surrounded by five monumental gates more than 65 feet high, each dominated by 4 huge carved faces of the king himself represented as the Buddha Avalokitesvara, facing north, south, east and west. In front of the south gate are giant statues of 54 gods on the left, 54 demons on the right. In the centre is the Bayon, a massive cluster of towers carved with 216 faces of the king as a bodhisatva. More great carvings are found on the 4000 feet of interior walls that are covered with bas-reliefs showing 11,000 figures engaged in battles, ceremonial pageants and everyday life of 12th century Angkor. Visit Phimeanakas, a 10th century temple built by Jayavarman V; the unfinished Baphuon; royal enclosure; Terrace of the Leper King and the Elephant Terrace, a viewing platform from which the kings of Angkor watched military processions; the Terrace of the Leper King, supposedly named after the founder of Angkor whom legend says was afflicted with leprosy and died of it. See the Baphuon of the mid-11th century dedicated to the Hindu god, Shiva, from a distance as restoration work is still going on here. Lunch at Sampheap Restaurant and rest a while at the hotel. Afternoon tour of Preah Khan dedicated to Buddhism and Neak Pean, both built by Jayavarman VII, the latter a healing place, and a couple of the lesser temples if there is time for them. Dinner at Angkor Reach Restaurant.	Overnight in hotel, Siem Reap

<b>DAY 3:</b>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at 8.30am to drive to the temple of Banteay Srei, 38 km from Siem Reap. It is the only pink sandstone temple exquisitely carved dated before Angkor Wat. Visit also Ta Prohm that is unrestored and left to the elements with giant trees embracing its stoneworks, giving Ta Prohm its unique character. Also visit Ta Keo, an 11th century sandstone temple dedicated to Shiva, Banteay Kdei in the image of Ta Prohm used as a monastery, Prasat Kravan and Sras Srang. Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, tour Angkor Wat located seven kilometres north of Siem Reap. Angkor Wat represents the spiritual and mystical grandeur of the Khmer civilization. The kingdom was founded in the early 9th century by King Suryavarman II as a microcosm of the mythical world in which he identified himself with the god Vishnu. At the heart of the city was a mountain temple, traditional home of the Hindu gods and also the centre of an earthly kingdom in which the king was regarded as sacred. The Temple served as a funerary for the king and was in use until 1431 when the kingdom was eliminated by the Siamese. The lost city was re-discovered by western archaeologists in the late 19th century.</p> <p>The temple complex of Angkor covers 200 acres, enclosed by a massive rectangular-shaped wall and surrounded by a moat. The wall contains gates on all four sides, with the main entrance richly decorated with carvings and sculptures. The temple comprised of five distinctive towers with 72 major monuments and an irrigation system that together portrayed the harmonization of Indian roots in a Cambodian context - which was the very foundation of Khmer art and architecture. This place is probably the largest religious monument ever built on earth, and is considered one of the most inspiring. Angkor Wat was declared a world heritage site by the United Nations. Dinner at Angkor Mondial Restaurant. Overnight in hotel, Siem Reap</p>	Overnight in hotel, Siem Reap
<b>DAY 4:</b>	<p><b>Breakfast at the hotel</b></p> <p>Breakfast at hotel. Morning boat trip on the Tonle Sap which is the largest fresh water source in all Southeast Asia - an ecological wonder, as the water of the Mekong River reverses itself during the height of the rainy season to flood the lake and re-fertilizes the land, thereby ensuring a food source of fish for the people. As the rains receded, the water from the lake flows out and down the Mekong River carrying in its load tons of fish that take weeks to harvest, whereupon they are dried and salted. See the floating gardens, floating villages complete with school, police station and fishing boats at work. Visit a local village on the way to the Great Lake to see traditional rural life. Transfer to airport for your departure flight. DEPARTURE from Siem Reap PM or Evening by PG flight to Bangkok. <b>Note: Late check out at 6PM is included.</b></p> <p>PM or Evening Arrive at Bangkok Airport.</p> <p>Change the Airplane to back to Hiroshima Airport ( No Fee to use Bangkok Airways Lounge - Free soft Drink, etc)</p>	
<b>DAY 5:</b>	<p>01:00AM Leave Bangkok to Hiroshima Airport</p> <p>08:20 AM Arrive at Hiroshima Airport</p>
